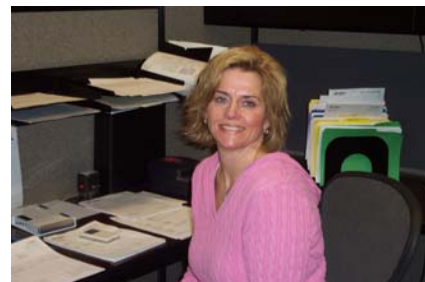

Not quite the Mason-Dixon Line...

Throughout my national travels, a personal favorite, and interesting region, lies south of the Mason-Dixon Line. This group of waste haulers are down south, yes, but a specific trend exists for the many states bordering the Gulf of Mexico. That area, specifically Texas, is an old stomping ground for me, but as far as containers and lids, these haulers have their own philosophy of the waste business and the products that are popular.

They do have the containers measuring at national standards for 8 yd, front load hauling; using the 36x58. They also developed other 8 yd. sized containers specific to this region; using the 36x54. Many customers, with our 36x46 lid, now convert their older cans, still applicable for refurbishing, by rotating the hingeline ears back to accommodate the lid length. Customers can feel secure, to know their container's will be able to maintain maximum longevity and not be brought in for repair due to a lid problem.
